- Beat the heat by making any of these summer drinks- lemonade, lassi, smoothies along with a yummy Oreo milkshake.

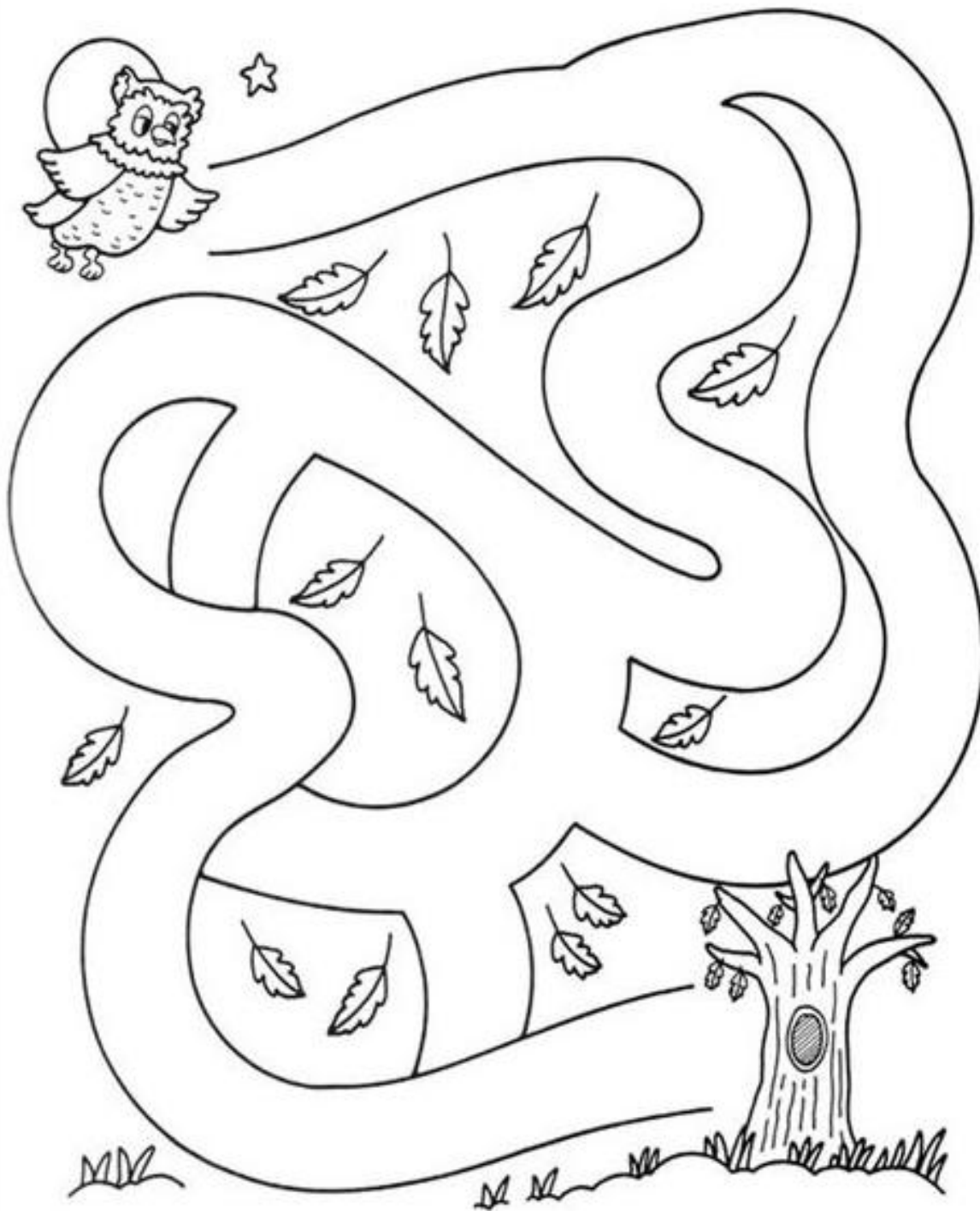
