Small words, big meaning!



In English, we use articles before nouns.

A

= one (singular)

We use **a** before a singular noun that begins with a **consonant sound**.

Examples:

a book a dog a teacher

**AN**

= one (singular)

We use **an** before a singular noun that begins with a **vowel sound** (a, e, i, o, u).

Examples:

an apple an elephant an umbrella

**THE**

= the specific one

We use **the** when we talk about something **specific** or something we already know.

Examples:

the book (this book)
the sun (the sun in the sky)
